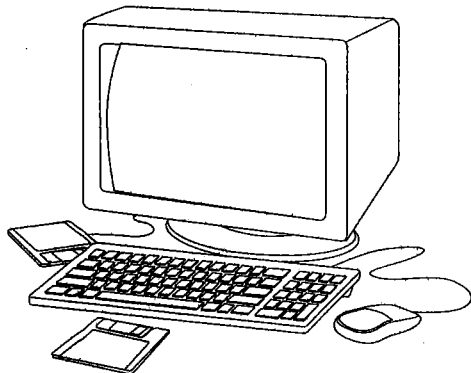

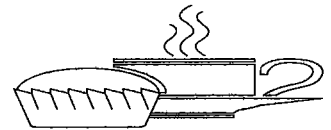
A Treasure(r) Hunt is Under Way!!!
